

## TAX WARRANT

**TO: ARSENE F. LETOURNEAU TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF ROUSES POINT**

You are hereby commanded to receive and collect from the several persons named in the assessment roll, hereunto annexed, the several sums named in the last column thereof opposite their respective names, for the following purposes:

Upon the delivery of the roll and warrant to you, and on or before the first day of June the Treasurer shall publish in the official paper of the Village, and post in five conspicuous places in the Village, a notice that such tax roll and warrant have been left with you for the collection of taxes therein levied, and shall designate one or more convenient places in the Village where you will receive taxes from June first to and including July first from 7:30 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

For said period of time you will receive all Taxes paid to you without additional charge.

On all such taxes remaining unpaid after July first, five per centum shall be added for the first month and an additional one per centum for each month and fraction thereof thereafter until paid.

Such notice shall also be published on week after the first publication in such newspaper.

You shall attend at the time and place specified in said notice for the purpose of receiving said taxes.

After the first day of July you shall proceed to collect the taxes remaining unpaid; with interest as herein provided, plus a \$2.00 Second Notice charge if sent and for the purpose you are possessed of all the powers of a Village Tax Collector.


All interest collected shall belong to the Village.

And for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
